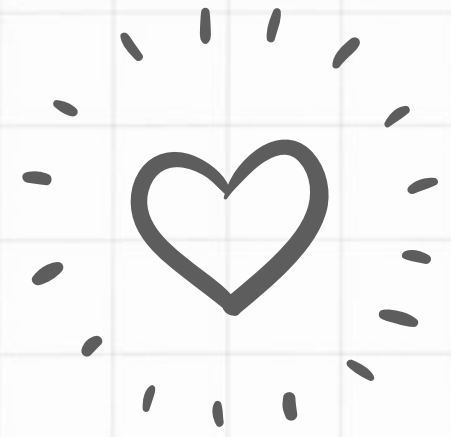
Worship begins in the heart and there are different ways to worship.



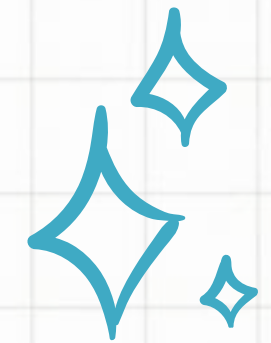

So when God told Abraham to take his son Isaac and offer him as a sacrifice on Mount Moriah, Abraham was worshipping God by bowing to God's will in obedience.

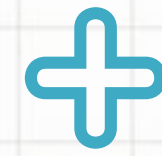

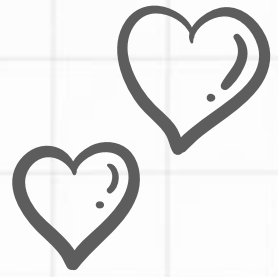


IN HEBREWS

Be thankful to Him and bless His name.”



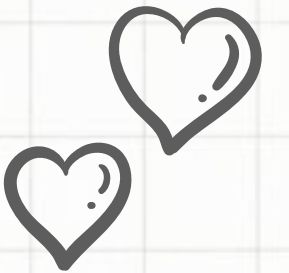


ABRAHAM ARRIVED READY!

- *And the fire for the flame.*



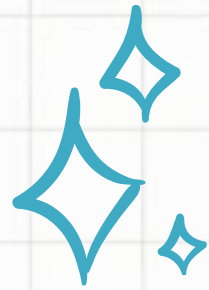
ISAIAH 6:1-3

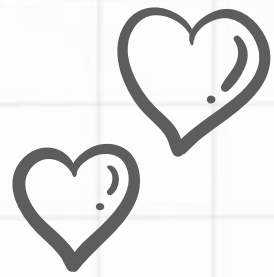
